

- Prior entering Clinical Skills Centre, each student of TMA is obliged to dress into a white medical coat, which must be clean and well-fitted.
- It is allowed to carry into the centre only essential things, required and permitted by the study process
- Students are obliged to wear clean shoes at the Clinical Skills Centre.
- Any of the following is strictly prohibited at the Centre:
 - ❖ Long and dirty fingernails;
 - ❖ Nail extensions;
 - ❖ Bold and extravagant manicure (bright, flashy nail polish);
 - ❖ Unbound long hair (shoulder length and longer hair must be bound);
 - ❖ Non-groomed beard;
 - ❖ Any sharp and specific odour;
 - ❖ Wearing any type of hat and/or sunglasses;
 - ❖ Wearing large earrings, necklaces and/or any large size accessories;
 - ❖ Wearing ring(s) and/or bracelets;
 - ❖ Wearing wristwatch while performing practical activities;
 - ❖ Bringing into the Centre any types of food or beverages
- During practical classes, mobile phones must be kept away and be in SILENT mode and any type of phone communication is allowed outside of the room with the permission of the class instructor (lecturer).
- In case, if a white coat is left at the Centre by the student, Clinical Skills Centre takes no responsibilities for its' damage or loss.

Failure to meet above stated regulations will result to following outcomes:

- Student will be given an official warning
- The offender will be excluded from the practical class and 0 points will be put in the corresponding block of class activity assessment)

Additional requirements which apply during examination process:

- During registration process prior examination, student must demonstrate student card
- no SMART watches, telephones or any other electronic devices are allowed at the Clinical Skills Centre during

Examination process.

In case of violating any of above stated requirements, student will be dismissed from the examination process and non-appearance will be recorded.

During study and examination processes, personal and prohibited items (coats, backpacks, mobile phones, SMART watches etc.) can be left at the entrance of the Centre, either on the cloak hangers or in safekeeping boxes.
