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EDUCATION AND PARTNERSHIP

Erasmus+ Institutional Development Grant

Petre Shotadze Tbilisi Medical Academy has been awarded the Erasmus+ Institutional Development grant.

The project called "LIFESTRAND" envisages the teaching/training of first aid skills for the population living in potentially highly militaristic risk zones in Georgia and Ukraine.

The project was designed, developed, and will be conducted directly under the coordination of TMA. The proposal envisages a collaborative project between 10 Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) from Georgia, Ukraine, Spain, and Portugal. The consortium includes the following HEIs:

GEORGIA (Petre Shotadze Tbilisi Medical Academy, Tbilisi State Medical University, Grigol Robakidze University, Alte University); UKRAINE (Ternopil National Medical University, Poltava State Medical University, Lugansk State Medical University); SPAIN (University of Santiago de Compostela, Association Semergen); PORTUGAL (University of Porto).

Academic staff and students of the participating universities will be involved in the project.

AMEE 2023 the 7th International Conference on Faculty Development in the Health Professions was hosted by Glasgow (Scotland) this year. Academy representatives had oral presentations and e-poster. Each year AMEE annual conference brings together professionals, educators, students, institutions, and organizations from various healthcare sectors, to share, collaborate, and network.



How Do We Increase Students' Motivation for Independent Learning?

How do we increase students' motivation for independent learning? To share personal experiences and innovations in the methodology of medical education, TMA hosted an interactive meeting. TMA lecturers reviewed the guidelines of the Association for Medical Education in Europe (AMEE) and the latest research published in the journal "Medical Teacher" in the direction of increasing student motivation and developing independent learning skills.

Erasmus+ Staff Mobility

Within the framework of Erasmus+ Staff Mobility, Tbilisi Medical Academy (TMA) hosted a delegation from Antwerp University. Workshops and trainings were held for TMA academic and visiting staff on the following topics: Assessment in Medical Education, Workplace Based Assessment (WPBA), peer teaching, and training of trainers.

The meetings were chaired by Nelle Michel - Professor of the University of Antwerp, President of European Academy of Teachers in General Practice (EURACT), Board Member of the Educational Council at the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences at the University of Antwerp, Christine van den Bogerd, Communication Skills Trainer, and an Education Coordinator at the University of Antwerp, and Christoph Schotters - Coordinator of the Clinical Skills Center.

Within the framework of the training, the guests introduced the experience both from the University of Antwerp and from the international of teaching in the clinical environment, assessment methods, and feedback mechanisms to the TMA lecturers through presentations, group assignments, and role-plays. Also, in the framework of the meetings were discussed the importance of peer teaching, ways to train trainers, and the need to create a learning environment.



"Innovation and Technology for Medicine"

Within the frames of the first call for proposals of the joint programme "Georgia #I2Q - Innovation, Inclusion and Quality" of the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia and the World Bank created "Competitive Innovation Fund (#CIF)", the joint programme of Petre Shotadze Tbilisi Medical Academy and Ilia State University - "Innovation and Technology for Medicine" has been approved for funding.

The project aims to develop research components specific to a one-step medical education programme and to realize them via the application of the problem and project-based methodologies.



EDUCATION AND PARTNERSHIP

TMA at Antwerp University

The delegation of Tbilisi Medical Academy was hosted by Antwerp University. Within the framework of the meeting, a workshop was held on issues of post-graduate education of general practice doctors in Belgium.

The visit also included meetings with the staff of the International Department of the University of Antwerp and the so-called GP practice at the Antwerp University Clinic.



The World Congress of Dermatologists Singapore

Lali Mekokishvili, Dean of the School of Medicine of TMA, participated in the congress as the European Ambassador, international speaker, and co-chairman of the session. Her report was about modern treatment and prevention of staphylococcal infections. The World Congress of Dermatologists is held once every 4 years and this year more than 12,000 delegates attended the event.



Polish Pediatrician's Visit at TMA

Within the Erasmus+ Staff Mobility program, TMA hosted Jakub Nowicki, a pediatrician of the Faculty of Medicine and the Department of Neonatal Pathology and Pathology of the Bone and Joint System from Lodz Medical University (Poland).

The purpose of the working visit was to get acquainted with the peculiarities of clinical teaching, especially the pediatric stage, and to gain experience in clinical work in an international environment. Jakub Nowicki met with the representatives of the TMA administration and the lecturers implementing the pediatric training course. Within the framework of the workshop, the parties reviewed the features of clinical education (especially pediatrics) in Georgia and Poland.

Delegation from Medical University of Lodz at TMA

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ Staff Mobility program, Tbilisi Medical Academy (TMA) hosted a delegation from the Medical University of Lodz (Poland).

The visit aimed to exchange teaching practices and content regarding teaching medical and academic professionalism and communication skills to medical students. Also, getting to know the peculiarities of the stage of clinical training, especially rehabilitation training, and gain experience in clinical work in an international environment. In addition, the workshops were focused on deepening cooperation between the universities.



ERASMUS+ Project SAFEMED+

Another meeting of ERASMUS+ project SAFEMED+ consortium was hosted by Vilnius University (Vilnius, Lithuania). Within the framework of the working meeting was discussed the electronic version of the book which will be published within the project. Also, a workshop was held on the preparation of Virtual Objective Structured Clinical Examination (Virtual OSCE) scenarios, led by Spanish colleagues.



Training for Teachers

TMA's Faculty Development Department organized a week of training for teachers which was held at the Academy.

The goal of teacher training is to promote the professionalization of academic and invited staff in the direction of teaching-learning, assessment methods, and development of scientific-research skills.

EDUCATION AND PARTNERSHIP

Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin

The Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin and the Petre Shotadze Tbilisi Medical Academy are realizing the project "The Role of HPV in Cancer in Georgia" which is funded by the German Ministry of Education and Research.

Within the frames of the project, TMA team visited Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin (Berlin, Germany). This project aims to organize and implement the discussion of HPV involvement in cancer development and an appraisal of the current status of epidemiology, screening, and treatment to foster the development of screening activities and research.



TMA's Staff Obtained The Status of Medical Education Specialist

Three more representatives of TMA (Nino Sikharulidze, Salome Khubulava, and Dea Goderdzishvili) successfully completed four training courses organized by the Association for Medical Education in Europe (AMEE) and obtained the status of Medical Education Specialist.

The ESME - "Essential Skills in Medical Education" training courses offered by AMEE play important roles on the way to the European educational space.

TMA's Delegation at Lodz Medical University

Within frames of Erasmus+ Staff Mobility Programme, members of TMA staff, Natalia Kotchlashvili (International Affairs Department) and Salome Khubulava (Department of Histology, Cytology and Embryology) visited Lodz Medical University, in order to enhance current cooperation. TMA staff members had an opportunities to visit and actively participate in the activities of Medical Simulations Centre and Department for Histology, Cytology and Embryology.

Throughout the visit, meetings were organised with the managers of International Department, Centre for Medical Education, Scientific-Research Department and Doctorate School, where parties discussed potential areas of prospective cooperation and established grounds for joint activities.



Visit of Turkish Professors at TMA

Tbilisi Medical Academy hosted representatives of Karadeniz Technical University of Trabzon, Turkey. The working meeting was attended by Professor Dr. Sedat Keleş of the Chemistry Department of the Faculty of Sciences, Professor Dr. Nurhan Gümrükçüoğlu of the Faculty of Health Sciences, Professor Dr. Beytullah Ertem of the Faculty of Health Sciences and researcher and writer Rahman Ayhan.

The parties discussed the prospects of bilateral cooperation. It should be noted that a memorandum of understanding will be signed between the universities in the near future, which will allow both students and academic and administrative staff to benefit from exchange programs.



Meeting with the Editor of "Aversi" Magazine

Why is it important to provide people with medical information in an understandable language?! TMA hosted the editor of "Aversi" magazine, Mari Ashugashvili, to talk about this topic.

At the same time, Mari is a TMA graduate and a member of the TMA Alumni Club, who shared her experience with future colleagues.

She emphasized the importance of providing information to the public correctly and easily. How future doctors should talk not only to patients but also to their family members and in general to those who are interested in medical topics. What resources can be used to bring medical information to the masses, etc.

EDUCATION AND PARTNERSHIP

International Student Congress

TMA students participated in the International Student Congress of (Bio) Medical Sciences - ISCOMS 2023, where they presented the results obtained in the research projects through oral and poster presentations.

ISCOMS, as one of the world's leading student congresses in the field of (bio)medical sciences, aims to promote the international dissemination of student research and the results obtained during their implementation.



Memorandum with the University of Alexandria

TMA signed a memorandum with the University of Alexandria (Egypt). Cooperation with a new partner includes such opportunities as:

- Participation in exchange projects of academic staff, researchers, and employees;
- Training of students of partner universities in relevant institutions and specialized laboratories;

Visit of CIMED Leaders to TMA

TMA hosted the heads of the Center of Innovation in Medical Education (CIMED) Professor Jossete Denekens and Professor Herman Van Rossum (Antwerp / Belgium).

Within the framework of the visit, working meetings were held for three weeks with the participation of administrative, academic staff, and guest personnel. The results of innovative projects implemented in pilot mode and the ways of their further implementation in the program were discussed at the meetings.



CyberPatient Founder's Visit to TMA

Since 2021, Tbilisi Medical Academy has cooperated with the company CyberPatient in the field of simulation learning. Within the framework of this partnership, in May 2023, Tbilisi Medical Academy hosted Dr. Karim Qayumi, the founder of the simulation platform CyberPatient. Professor of Surgery at British Columbia University and an expert in medical education, Professor Qayumi shared his knowledge and experience on simulation learning with TMA faculty and students. During an interactive meeting Professor Karim Qayumi shared insights on "The importance of simulation learning for competency based education".



TMA's Resident at the International Congress

Ana Jibladze, a resident of obstetrics and gynecology of the Tbilisi Medical Academy, presented a report at the 19th World Congress of Human Reproduction. The scientific paper "Evaluation of gender and psychosexual characteristics in patients with various forms of androgen resistance syndrome" was co-authored and supervised by Professor Genaro Kristesiashvili. The speaker discussed more than 40 cases and received great interest and approval from the audience.

In addition, Ana Jibladze personally received the highest assessment from the president of the International Academy of Human Reproduction, Professor Andrea Jenazani.

"How Do I Find a Source of Motivation?"

"How do I find a source of motivation?" - TMA organized training for students, that was led by psychologist and trainer Nino Buadze.

The nature of motivation, mechanism, and sources of motivation were discussed at the meeting filled with interaction and various activities. During the meeting, students developed an individual strategy to achieve their goals, which would give them the benefit of applying these skills in life. Also, they talked about the connection between motivation and self-esteem and the dispositions that prevent them from staying more motivated during the learning process.



Conference "Medical Simulations - Look at the Future"

The Vice-Rector of TMA in International Affairs and SAFEMED+ project coordinator Ia Avaliani and the head of the TMA Clinical Skills Center and SAFEMED+ project Akaki Sepashvili participated in the conference "Medical Simulations – Look at the Future".

An online conference was held under the auspices of Bukovin State Medical University (Ukraine) Akaki Sepashvili presented a presentation on the dissemination of SAFEMED+ within the framework of the event, which reviewed the main objectives, results, and challenges of the project.

European Digestive Surgery International Conference

With the academic partnership of TMA, Ilia State University (ISU) organized the 15th European Digestive Surgery International Conference (European Digestive Surgery 2023).

The conference program included traditional challenges and modern achievements in digestive medicine as well as in other related fields (oncology, gastroenterology, radiology, transplantology, etc.)



Visit of International Partners at TMA

TMA hosted a working visit to Professor Katia Mangano and Professor Roberto Di Marco, who represented partner University of Catania of the Erasmus+ project SAFEMED+, and Professor Mario Ollero - Professor at Université Paris Est Créteil (France). The purpose of the meeting was to share experiences between the parties and plan future cooperation. During the visit, the discussion was about the SAFEMED+ project, which aims to introduce and develop competency-based medical simulation training in the participant universities, which in turn ensures the formation of appropriate clinical competencies among graduates. In addition, introduce innovations in medical education, share experience, and strengthen the clinical line with a modern approach.



Can Healthcare be Accessible for Everyone and What Should be Done to Achieve This?

"Health for all" - This year, the World Health Organization (WHO) is celebrating the 75th anniversary of World Health Day with this slogan. TMA hosted a public lecture in recognition of this date. The lecture was led by Professor Amiran Gamkrelidze, an expert in Public Health. "Can healthcare be accessible for everyone and what should be done to achieve this" – was the title of the talk during which the speaker discussed topics like the main challenges of the 21st century in healthcare, the main factors affecting human health, how they can be prevented and managed, inequity in health care, its social, economic or other determinants.

Photo Exhibition "6 Days of the Country Doctor" in Batumi

Batumi Shota Rustaveli State University (BSU) hosted a photo exhibition of the social project "6 Days of the Country Doctor" implemented by Tbilisi Medical Academy (TMA). The exhibition was attended by project-participating students and doctors, Minister of Health and Social Protection of Adjara Nino Nizharadze, representatives of the National Center for Disease Control and Public Health, Batumi University Rector and administration representatives, students, and citizens interested in the exhibition. The project received a response from the media. The exhibition was broadcast live on the Public Broadcaster's program "Private Dr. Mari Malazonia". Information about the exhibition was covered in the local media, in particular, on the Adjara Public Broadcaster's program "Morning Wave", the student participating in the project, Nino Gagua spoke live about the project, and the exhibition was also covered by the Adjara Public Broadcaster and in the news programs of Channel 25.



"Georgian Down Syndrome Association" at TMA

TMA hosted the representatives of "Georgian Down Syndrome Association" and their beneficiaries. The public lecture "with us and not for us" was led by the head of the association's health and social direction, director of the "Gigos Foundation" Rusudan Mghebrishvili.

The event was also attended by Nino Sikharulidze, the founder of the Down Syndrome Association, and the manager of the social results of "Babale" social enterprise. She spoke about the activities of "Babale".

"6 Days of Country Doctor" Second Season

The photo project "6 Days of Country Doctor" has started. Tbilisi Medical Academy is implementing the trans-disciplinary student photo project for the second time. As a result of motivational letters, the special jury selected six students who this time will introduce the everyday life and work process of the doctors of the highland villages of Guria to the public through photos.

Students participating in the second stage of the photo project are Ninutsi Pangani, Lika Kekelidze, Saba Zakradze, Salome Mumladze, Lela Koriauli, and Tamaz Okruashvili. In the first stage of the project, together with Leli Blagonravova, they will learn the basics of photography, as well as master the techniques of storytelling and writing. Later, they will go on an expedition, observe the work process of Gurian doctors, and make notes. At the final stage of the project, a magazine will be published and a photo exhibition will be organized.

The first stage of the photo project was implemented in the mountainous Ajara. Six students of TMA introduced to society the daily life of doctors living in the villages of Skhalta, Ghorjom, and Khulo and shared the profession of a doctor seen from their perspective.

Euromelanoma 2023

Within the framework of the skin cancer awareness raising campaign "Euromelanoma," Tbilisi Medical Academy (TMA) and Photodermatology and Skin Cancer Association of Georgia organized a free screening of the population in Adjara.

Free screening of the population was provided by specialists from Tbilisi and Batumi. Also, students of the Faculty of Medicine of TMA and BSU participated in the examinations. More than 150 citizens of different ages throughout Batumi were given the opportunity to be examined and consulted by the doctors. The first day of screening was held at Batumi University; The Dean of TMA Lali Mekokishvili, and students took part, and on the second day TMA Dean, invited professors from Tbilisi and TMA students went to Khulo, where they conducted Melanoma screening free of charge for the population of Khulo municipality.

Turkey

31 more TMA students departed for Turkey with the exchange program.

Within the framework of the bilateral exchange program, students will undergo internships at the Research Hospitals of Atatürk University (Erzurum) and Recep Tayyip Erdoğan University (Rise).

Students will have the opportunity to spend three weeks in the following departments: Gynecology and Obstetrics, Emergency medicine, Pediatrics, Internal Medicine, General Surgery, Cardiology.



Project "Lab-Orator"

Organized by Tbilisi Medical Academy (TMA) students and Tbilisi State Medical University (TSMU) Student Self-Government Education Committee, a lecture on the topic: "Rheology in Clinical Medicine and Rehabilitation" was held as part of the "Lab-orator" project. The goal of the project was to raise awareness about rheology and biorheology in society. The project was conducted in three stages, In the first stage interested students listened to a lecture, as a result of which 20 best students were selected. The second stage of the "lab-orator" was hosted by the laboratory of the Ivane Beritashvili Experimental Biomedicine Center, where the students underwent practical training. And, at the third, final stage, a student conference was held in TMA, where the students participating in the project made presentations in groups and the best of them were identified by a special jury. Also, students participating in the conference were given the opportunity to present reports at ReobioMed 2023.



Lithuania

20 students of TMA departed to Klaipeda (Lithuania) on an exchange program.

Students will undergo internships in different departments within the bilateral exchange program: Cardiology, Ophthalmology, Reanimatology, Neurosurgery, Endocrinology, Gynecology, Pediatrics, Traumatology, Anesthesiology, General Surgery.



Planetary Health and Its Correlation With Medicine

What is planetary health and why is it so crucial for us as health professionals? - A seminar on this topic was held in TMA, organized by the Eco Club. The event, which was dedicated to World Environment Day, was led by Maka Maglakelidze, the Head of the Institutional Culture Development Department of TMA, and Rishu Shah, a student of TMA. They shared their experiences in planetary health with the audience.

Within the framework of the meeting, Maka Maglakelidze reviewed her research, the main goal of which was to study the impact of air pollution on the exacerbation and hospitalization of asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).

The event was organized by the Dandy TMA Neurosurgery Club. The conference aimed to provide the audience with information on neurology, psychiatry, behavioral science, psychology, and neurosurgery.

European Students’ Union at TMA

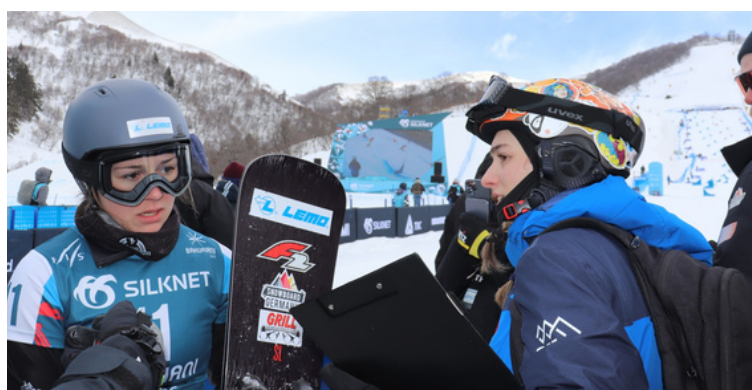

TMA students volunteered in Bakuriani, which hosted the World Championships in Freestyle, Snowboard, and Freeski. Our students were distributed on the ski slopes and supervised the athletes. The championship was held under the auspices of the International Ski Federation (FIS) and about 700 athletes from 42 countries (Austria, Switzerland, France, Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Australia, South Africa, China, Japan, Canada, USA, etc.) participated in it.



Open Door Days at TMA

Every year TMA organizes open-door days for prospective students. The Academy hosted applicants interested in medicine in /March, April, and May. They participated in the simulation training "One Day at the Clinic" and performed medical procedures on medical simulators and models in a completely safe environment. In 2023, more than 100 prospective students got to know the TMA.



Winter School of Arrhythmia

Bakuriani hosted another session of the Winter School of Arrhythmia. The event was held with the organization the Winter School of Arrhythmia and the support of the Tbilisi Medical Academy. About 60 students from five medical universities in Georgia participated in the winter school.

During the two-day session, students participated in various practical seminars and workshops. Also, an intellectual game was held in the reading of electrocardiography, in which TMA students Lasha Agulashvili and Sophio Shamugia won prizes.

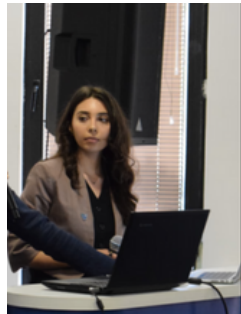

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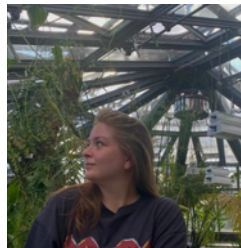

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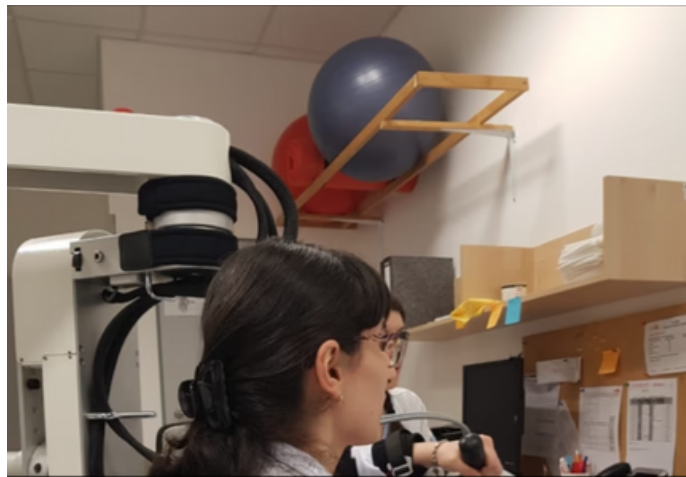
